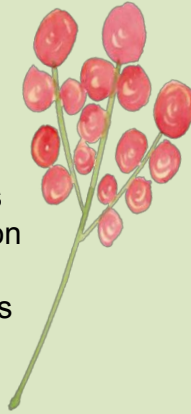
## Meeting The Needs Of Those In Crisis

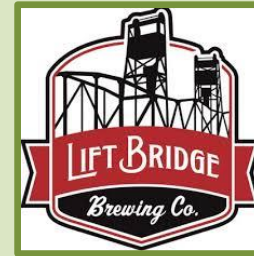
